Terms:
OSFC Capacity Sq. Footage:

Calculated Capacity that uses the square footage of the facility and divides it by the allotted square footage per student according to the State of Ohio School Design Manual.

NOTE: OSFC co-funds based on square footage capacity for each grade level (i.e. K-5, 6-8, 9-12).

CCS Program Capacity:

Calculated Capacity that calculates how Columbus City Schools uses spaces for programs in each school, regardless of square footage. Typically only regular education classrooms and special education classrooms get capacity in an elementary school.

Modular CR's & Modular Capacity

Refers to how many modular (portables) that are used as classrooms at each school. The number of modular classrooms is multiplied by 25 students to calculate capacity.

Adjusted Enrollment

Official Fall 2015 enrollment count at each school as reported to the State of Ohio.
